*The summer has come to an end, and we are preparing for the fall here on the North Georgia lakes. We want to bring to your attention that it is time to bring in swim buoys on our North Georgia Lakes.*

*Swim buoys as you know, are only permitted in/on GPC lakes between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Please remove all buoys that are currently in the Lake. Do not forget to bring your swim mats back flush with the end of your dock, as well as removing any existing floats at this time.*

*Any buoys not removed are subject to removal by GPC. I do realize that everyone is not a full-time lake resident, therefore GPC will grant a two-week grace period for removal from the receipt of this letter.*
